### TARGET AUDIENCE:

- Classroom teachers who are regularly practising P4C
- The sessions will be based around the SAPERE model
- It is desirable but not essential that participants have completed their Level 1 SAPERE training

Topics covered will include:

- How to systematically develop thinking skills from Foundation Stage upwards.
- How to become a more skilled facilitator
- How to develop the 4Cs of thinking
- How to get more philosophical questions
- Selecting a good philosophical stimulus
- How to use concept stretcher activities
- Areas drawn from the needs of the group
